Visa Requirements:

You must ensure that passport validity exceeds six months, and at all cases, more than the residence period, with making sure to get beforehand an entry -to -Egypt valid visa, should it be required. For those participants who wish to get an entry visa to Egypt, communicate with the nearest Egyptian embassy/ diplomatic consulate at their residence

with the nearest Egyptian embassy/ diplomatic consulate at their residence country. In countries where there is no Egyptian diplomatic representation, please contact us via email at asa@incosai2025.eg and provide the names of the delegation members along with copies of their passports valid for at least six months, specifying the point of entry, so that we can take the necessary steps for issuing Entry Visas.

Arrival and Departure from the Airport:

• There is one main airport in Sharm El-Sheikh which is: Sharm El-Sheikh International Airport, which is about a 15-minute drive from the Congress venue or the hotels.



Transportation Support

Transportation for Participants:

- Free transportation will be provided to all participants.
- Please inform your delegation liaison officer of any changes to your flight information immediately, preferably at least one month before the Congress.
- At the airport, the ad hoc team will welcome the participants, and will be holding a sign with the name "XXV INCOSAI" and the Logo of the Accountability State Authority - SAI EGYPT, will accompany them to the means of transportation.
 - From the hotel to the Congress venue and back on Congress days according to the Program.
 - From the hotel or Congress venue to dinner venue and back.
 - From the hotel to the Social Program and back.

Other means of transportation:

- Participants may use taxi services at their own discretion through electronic applications.
- It is worth noting that the responsibility for using any (private) transportation is up to the user.

- The Congress will make available special rates for hotel accommodation reservations (all are located in vicinity of the Congress venue).
- All designated hotels will provide the following:
 - WiFi services
 - Business services, amenities and entertainment facilities

Hotel Policies:

- Please review policy hotel to know check-in, checkout time, cancellation and/or reservations change.
- All Participants bear cost of rooms booked based on their request and settlement of any fees or fines or additional bills (phone calls, room service, etc.) before departure.

Credit Cards, currency and ATMs

- The Egyptian pound is the official currency. Foreign currency can be exchanged at banks, exchange offices, major hotels and some ATMs, banks may charge transaction fees, and you must have your passport with you when exchanging currencies.
- US dollars and euros are also accepted.

- ATMs will be available in the area surrounding the Congress venue and in the designated hotels.
- Credit cards are accepted in Sharm El-Sheikh (e.g., Visa, MasterCard, etc.).

Medical Services

- Primary medical care will be provided and participants are advised to obtain an international travel insurance policy.
- A first aid Clinic will be available at the Congress venue, and ambulances will be present throughout all Congress proceedings for emergency cases. It is noteworthy that Sharm El-Sheikh International Hospital is approximately 16.5 kilometers (about a 15-minute drive) from the Congress venue.



Electricity

Egypt is working on energy source with 220V power supply, 50Hz frequency, and 2-pin AC power plug.



Weather

- Maximum temperatures range between 25 and 30 degrees Celsius.
- Minimum temperatures range between 15 and 20 degrees Celsius.

- If you don't have roaming services enabled, all major telecom operators in Egypt offer temporary holiday SIM cards for tourists.
 Visit any store, WE, Orange, Vodafone or Etisalat and request a temporary SIM card with plenty of call minutes and internet data.
 You could also inquire about purchasing a portable wireless router with a large data package. It is recommended to carry your passport when purchasing the aforementioned services.
- Internet WiFi service will also be provided at the Congress venue.
